Comparative:

I am older than my wife.

English weather is worse than French weather.

Superlative:

My house is the biggest one in my family.

This shirt is the cheapest in this shop.

Monaco is the best football team in France.

'There are' in the past: 'There were'

When Bill was young, there were only two channels on TV.

Who did you go with? = Avec qui y es-tu allé?
